Comment:	Widerstehe doch der Sünde (Just resist sin), BWV 54, is a church cantata by Johann Sebastian Bach. He composed the solo cantata for alto in Weimar, probably for the seventh Sunday after Trinity and first performed it on 15 July 1714. It is his first extant church cantata for a solo voice. The prescribed readings for the Sunday are from the Epistle to the Romans, the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life (Romans 6:19--23),... (more online)
