Dr. Matthew McConnell holds a B.A. degree in Music from Bennington College, a M.M. degree in Musical Composition with Distinction in Performance (and Academic Honors) from the New England Conservatory of Music, and as a Doctor of Musical Arts (D.M.A.) degree from the same institution. His instructors have included Stephen Siegel, Allen Shawn, John Heiss, and Hollywood composer Erik Lundborg (composition); Dr. Dwight Killam (organ); Daniel Pinkham (organ, harpsichord, and sacred music); Ann Cain, Jane Jenkins, and John Van Buskirk (piano); and Lee Hyla (orchestration). He is a member of ASCAP and the American Guild of Organists.

Dr. McConnell was a Teaching Fellow at the New England Conservatory of Music 2006-2008. He currently teaches composition, piano, organ, orchestration, keyboard harmony and music theory, and is a Schillinger scholar, teaching The Schillinger System of Musical Composition.
